Art and Photography Field Trip Thursday 24th October to Monday 28th October 2019

The art and design department has planned the annual field trip this autumn to St Ives in Cornwall. This period of study has become a vital focus for a student's development in this subject area. It is available for both year 12 and 13 students.

The dates are from Thursday 24th October, returning to Sackville School on Monday 28th October 2019. The accompanying staff will be Mr Andrews as the field trip organiser and Ms Buckley as the art teacher.

Students will be accompanied by members of the art teaching team on the minibuses. Personal luggage will also be couriered down in the minibus.

Accommodation has been booked at The Cohort Hostel, St Ives. Breakfast, packed lunches and evening meals will be provided each day.

On Thursday, after the evening meal, students will have the opportunity to visit St Ives harbour to develop a series of night studies, leading to either a one hour intense final painting, or a critical look at the shots taken by photography students.

We propose spending Friday 25th October in St Ives at the Tate Gallery and the Barbara Hepworth Museum with coastal studies in the afternoon. On Saturday 26th October we will visit Penzance and view Newlyn Art Gallery, The Exchange and Penlee House Gallery with coastal views up to St Michael's Mount. On Sunday 27th October we will look at the local architecture of St Ives with walks around the cove and the working fishing port, with an afternoon visit to Patrick Heron's Eagles Nest near Zennor. Alternative arrangements will be made for another venue, if necessary, depending on the weather.

Each evening the students will be required to paint, document their digital photo shoots or work with mixed media to show development from the day's observations in a studio space on site.

The cost of the trip is £290, which will cover hostel accommodation, food, transport, gallery tariffs and other incidental costs. Insurance for all school trips is arranged through West Sussex County Council. Peanuts or peanut related products are not allowed to be taken on any school visit.

If you would like your child to attend, please return the slip below with a non-refundable deposit of £100 (payable online or by cheque payable to Sackville School) by 6th September 2019 at the latest; the final balance is to be paid by 27th September 2019. If further staged payments are required to even out the cost, this can be arranged by contacting me directly.
