BTEC Performing Arts - Edward Scissorhands at Sadler's Wells

Students on the BTEC Performing Arts course have the exciting opportunity to watch a production of 'Edward Scissorhands' on **Thursday 18 January 2024** at Sadler's Wells, London. The performance is choreographed by Matthew Bourne, one of the practitioners we study in Unit 1. The opportunity of seeing Bourne's work is incredibly beneficial to the creative process across the course as well as written elements.

Please could students meet at 11.10am in P block, ready to leave school at approximately 11.30am. We will be travelling by coach. The performance will begin at 2.30pm and will be returning to school at approximately 6.45pm where students can be collected from the main entrance.

Students are permitted to bring money with them for a programme or snack; however, it is their responsibility and should be no more than £20.00. Sadler's Wells does accept cash and card.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £42.00, which will cover the cost of the visit including their ticket and coach travel. I must however tell you, that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless parents, who are able to, are willing to contribute.
