Beliefs & Values GCSE

As we move into the autumn half term, I am emailing to remind you that our year 10 students will be sitting their beliefs & values (religious studies) GCSE this academic year. The provisional exam timetables have now been published, so I can inform you that the exams will take place the morning of **Thursday 9 May 2024** (paper 1) and the afternoon of **Thursday 16 May 2024** (paper 2).

In preparation for these external exams, the school will be running two mock exams. The first of these will be on the morning of **Monday 20 November 2023** and will cover paper 1 material – the beliefs, teachings and practices of Christianity and Islam. Your child's class teacher will be running in-class revision sessions, and setting revision homework, in the coming weeks. There will also be opportunities to attend after-school revision sessions and the VLE section of the student intranet contains a wealth of revision materials:

If you are purchasing revision materials outside of school, please ensure that they are produced specifically for the **AQA Religious Studies A** specification.
