CEW Coding at Bletchley Park – Tuesday 15 July 2025

We are absolutely delighted to inform you about an exciting educational opportunity for the students as part of the Curriculum Enhancement Week. We have arranged a trip to the historic Bletchley Park on Tuesday 15 July 2025.

Students should arrive at school reception at 7.45am to leave promptly at 8.00am. We will arrive back at school at approximately 4.30pm depending on traffic.

- Lunch - All students will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink for the day. **Nut related products are not allowed to be taken on any school visit.**
- Appropriate clothing - Please ensure your child wears clothing suitable for the weather conditions on the day.
- Comfortable shoes - There will be a significant amount of walking involved during the visit, so comfortable and sturdy shoes are essential.
- Medication - If your child requires any personal medication, please ensure they bring it with them and that the school has been informed of any specific medical needs.

We believe this trip will be a memorable and highly educational experience for our pupils, bringing history to life in a truly engaging way.
