## Curriculum Enhancement Week - Science - Monday 17 July 2023 to Wednesday 19 July 2023

With our curriculum enhancement days fast approaching I wanted to provide you with more details on what is included as part of the science days starting on Monday 17 July 2023.

## Monday 17 July 2023

Students should **arrive at school at the normal time of 8.25am and go to A28** where they will be registered. We will start the day with a fun science based challenge and then students will begin researching and investigating their own science project. Students do not need to be in school uniform on this day.

## Tuesday 18 July 2023

We will be visiting the Science Museum in London, travelling by train from East Grinstead Train Station. We will be leaving on the 9.36am train to London Victoria. **Students will need to meet us outside the entrance to East Grinstead Train Station at 9.10am.** 

We will then travel from London Victoria to Hyde Park for lunch, via the underground and then continue on to the Science Museum. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water for the day. Any students that are eligible for free school meals will have a lunch provided for them that morning. Once in the Science Museum we have a day of exploring planned. Students will be able to visit the Science Museum shop at the end of the day. If they would like to buy themselves a small gift, please ensure they have some money with them. We recommend not bringing more than £10.00.

We will then return to East Grinstead, via the underground and train. We are planning to be on the 3.50pm train from London Victoria back to East Grinstead, arriving at 4.50pm. We ask that you collect your child from the station at this time. If you are happy for your child to make their own way home from the station, please could you indicate this on the consent form at the bottom of this letter. In case of train delays, we will ask students to call you to confirm our arrival time. If they are unable to contact you a member of staff will contact you to let you know of our adjusted arrival time.

Due to the nature of this trip we request that all students are in school uniform.

## Wednesday 19 July

We will be back in school for the day. **Students should meet in room A28 at 8.25am** to be registered. During the day students will complete their projects and present their findings to staff on a poster display board. Students do not need to be in school uniform on this day.

Students are expected to wear normal school uniform on Thursday 20 July and Friday 21 July.
