Curriculum Enhancement Week Theatrical Production and Dance - Monday 14 to Wednesday 16 July 2025

With our curriculum enhancement week fast approaching, I wanted to provide you with more details on what is included as part of the theatrical production and dance days starting on Monday 14 July 2025.

Monday 14 and Tuesday 15 July 2025 - Theatrical Production

Students will take part in a series of musical theatre workshops and build towards a final performance, one day of the workshops will be focused on Oliver. Students will also have the opportunity to create sets or costumes based on Oliver. Please ensure students are wearing clothes they can move in, trainers and bring plenty of water. Students should register in room PO2 on all three days

Monday 14 and Tuesday 15 July 2025 - Dance

Students will learn choreography from the musical Oliver, they will also learn different contemporary and musical theatre dance techniques. Students will then have the opportunity to perform what they have learnt on Tuesday afternoon. Please ensure students are wearing clothes they can move in, trainers and bring plenty of water. Students should register in room P01 on all three days

Wednesday 16 July 2025 - Oliver Performance

- Students should meet us at school at 8.25am, once we have discussed the plan for the day we will walk to East Grinstead train station. Students can wear their own clothes for the trip.
- Once we arrive at Victoria we will make our way towards the theatre, stopping at some of the famous historical sights.
- We will break for lunch in St James Park, please can students bring a packed lunch with them. **No nut** related products are allowed to be taken on any school visit.
- The production of the Oliver starts at 2.30pm and finishes at approximately 5.15pm. If students wish to bring some money to purchase a drink or a program we advise no more than £20.00. Please note that it might be card only.
- We will arrive back at East Grinstead train station at 7.20pm. Please complete the <u>Google form</u> to tell us about collection plans for your child.
