## Everybody's Talking About Jamie - Trip to Theatre Royal, Brighton

We are delighted to offer our KS4 students in the Yousafzai community the very exciting opportunity to see a live showing of 'Everybody's Talking About Jamie', which is on a UK tour, at the Theatre Royal in Brighton on **Wednesday 1 November 2023**. This is a fantastic chance to see a West End musical in a relatively local theatre.

Students and staff will meet at Sackville at 5.00pm where we will then depart in a minibus and park in Brighton. Due to time constraints, students will not necessarily have a chance to buy food or drinks so we recommend bringing a packed dinner, snacks and a drink. We may however, depending on the journey time, have some free time in the theatre to buy drinks and snacks for the performance. We intend to be back at Sackville at 12.00am. As we will be back so late, we expect students to be picked up from school rather than making their own way home.

We have tried to keep the cost of this trip as low as possible. There are 30 tickets available and, should demand outstrip supply, students' names will be entered into a spreadsheet and placed on the trip randomly allocated to 30 students.

Tickets will be £26.00 and will be available on MCAS from today, Monday 18 September 2023.

Please remember if your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium government grant we can use that to pay for the cost of the ticket. If you <u>do not</u> wish us to do this, please get in touch with Mrs Nibloe (<u>hnibloe@sackvilleschool.org.uk</u>).
