For hygiene reasons please could any donations be washed, preferably without fabric softener to retain the absorbency of the fabric.





# **Internship Programme 2024**

For those interested in a career in teaching this programme is specifically designed for undergraduates interested in getting experience of a career in teaching.

Government funding of £300 per week (£900 total) is available for secondary Maths, Physics, Chemistry, MFL and Computing interns, but there are also programmes for all other secondary subject specialisms and primary teaching on an unfunded basis. The programme is based across multiple schools in Surrey, Berkshire, London and Sussex and will run for 3 weeks this summer (dates to be confirmed – but it is likely to be 24<sup>th</sup> June to 12<sup>th</sup> July 2023).
