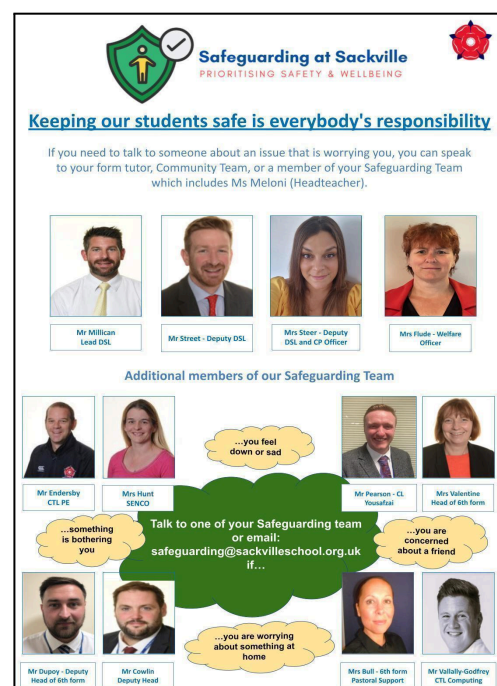



Are you a parent or carer of one or more children aged 9 to 17 who wants to help develop resources for parents/carers about online child sexual exploitation and abuse (OCSEA), particularly online grooming (OG)?

Would you like to advise us on adapting our ground-breaking, research-based DRAGON-Shield training for child-safeguarding practitioners into resources to help parents/carers to build their knowledge about OG communication to better support their children?

How can you help?

Working with the Breck Foundation, we are looking to recruit parents/carers of one or more children aged 9-17 to consult on developing our DRAGON-Shield training for a parent/carer audience. You will be invited to:

- Attend a **virtual welcome meeting** with the DRAGON and Breck Foundation teams (30 minutes) – Monday 19th May 2025
- Complete a **brief online survey** to help identify current knowledge and perceived needs (15 minutes) – May 2025
- Attend **2 virtual co-creation workshops**, led by the DRAGON team with support from the Breck Foundation (4 hours overall) – Monday 19th May and Monday 16th June 2025.

Based on your input, the DRAGON team will then develop DRAGON-Shield for parents/carers: an OG prevention and support-oriented resource for a parent/carer audience in a format aimed at widespread dissemination.

What's in it for me?
