Mock Art Exam Deadlines and Tate Modern Trip

I am writing to you regarding some important upcoming events for all year 11 art students. As you may already know the year 11's will be completing a two day (10 hour) mock art exam on Thursday 1 and Friday 2 December. The idea behind the two day exam is that students have the opportunity to create a sustained piece of artwork that shows developed ideas, and refinement of technical skills linked to their surreal and distorted portraiture project. Students will complete the work outside of their sketchbook and can use any materials they choose. They should have practised using this material prior to the exam to ensure they know what they are doing. Their pieces can be 3D or 2D and on canvas, cardboard, wood, stretched paper or fabric.

The mock exam will not signify the end of the project, as they will have till Tuesday 3 January 2023 to hand this in. The 3 January signifies the end of their coursework and they will be given their externally set exam paper from AQA the following week. The exam project will last from January through to Easter where they will complete their official final art exam. The mock exam will also be really good practice for their final exam next year.

Leading up to their mock exam students will need to spend not only their two hours of lesson time, but at least two hours of their own time preparing. Students know that the art rooms are free to use most breaks, lunches and after school. They should always check in with their art teacher first before using a classroom. Students have also been given checklists and booklets, as well as access to resources on Google Classroom to help them. With the addition of sketchbooks this year, students should really be taking extra special care of presenting their ideas and work in their books and taking them home after each lesson. Students must not forget their sketchbooks for lessons as this is a vital part of the lead up to the mock exam.

I would also like to make you aware that we will be taking the year 11 art students to the Tate Modern in February 2023 as part of their upcoming externally set exam project starting in January. All students will be expected to attend as this is a key part of the project allowing them to draw from a wide variety of artwork in the flesh. Students will be expected to bring their books with them on the visit along with a series of drawing materials. They will need to be in school uniform and have a packed lunch with them. There will be a separate letter sent home at the start of December with all of the details, costs and timings of the trip.

Final coursework deadline - Tuesday 3 January 2023 (3.00pm)
Externally set exam project begins - Monday 9 January 2023
Tate Modern visit - Friday 10 February 2023 (all day)
