## Year 12 Information Letter

Meet the Tutors and Sixth Form Information Evening, Thursday 18 January 2024 at 5.30pm in school We strongly recommend all sixth form students and families to attend our sixth form information evening on Thursday 18 January 2024 at 5.30pm. Year group specific sessions will be held for year 12 and year 13 and tutors will be present to meet their tutees and families. There will be opportunities to ask questions to the 6th form team, as well as a variety of short information sessions during the evening. You will select the relevant sessions for your child's year group. I will send out more information about this shortly. Please can I ask you to make every effort to attend this face to face meeting. It is an excellent opportunity to learn more about school sixth form life as well as an opportunity to have your queries answered.

## Attendance and supervised study

## **Car Registration Numbers**

It is strongly recommended that students who drive to school and park locally, let us know their car registration details. We are sometimes asked by members of the public about the registration details of cars parked badly or blocking an entrance in Bourg de Peage Avenue or Warburton Close. If we know who the car belongs to, this saves the car being reported, in exceptional circumstances, to the police. With that in mind, please can I implore you to ask your child to park responsibly and drive carefully and within the speed limit in Bourg de Peage Avenue, especially bearing in mind a large primary school is located opposite our school.
