



English Exam Details

Mrs Grimes - Curriculum Leader of English

Year 11 mocks will be:

- Language Paper 2
- Literature Paper 2 Lord of the Flies, power and conflict poetry and unseen poetry.

Students should start revising by re-reading the texts for literature and exploring the revision resources posted for them on Google Classroom by their class teacher.

English boost sessions for Year 11 are taking place every Wednesday at 3.00pm in D block.

Maths Exam Details

Mr Moodley - Curriculum Leader of Maths

Year 11 students will be sitting all three exam papers in the coming mock:

- Paper 1 Non-calculator
- Paper 2 Calculator
- Paper 3 Calculator

To revise effectively for GCSE Maths, prioritize active learning by practicing past papers and targeted topic questions rather than just reading notes.

Create a realistic revision timetable with short, frequent study sessions to build understanding little and often.

Understand the mark scheme and learn how to write down clear, concise working for every step. Students must focus on working through more problem solving and reasoning questions to a good understanding of how to answer these questions and what is expected from the mark scheme. Science Exam - Revision Resource

A revision resource has been purchased for your child to help them prepare for their two sets of mocks and final GCSE exam in Year 11.

The website is https://www.my-gcsescience.com/login/.

Their username for the website is their full school email (their normal school username with '@mysackville.co.uk' at the end) and everyone's password is set to 'twa'.

Please do not change the email or password as only the company has the facility to reset passwords.

This website contains video explanations specifically tailored to their AQA specification, includes extra videos for those students studying the separate (triple) science subjects, and more importantly providing low stakes multiple choice quizzes and more rigorous practice exam questions (with answers) for students to check their memory and understanding.

In order to access the videos, please click on the green DNA (Biology), the red molecule (Chemistry) or the blue atom (Physics) symbols at the top right of the website.

For mock 1, students will need to revise the topic sections listed below:

To support your child with their revision, you could:

- · Re-test them using the multiple choice questions from videos they have completed previously
- Ask them to re-explain things they have made notes on during the video
- Time them for one minute per mark in exam conditions for the practise questions.
