## School Uniform

As we approach the end of the school year I felt it was important to write to outline our expectations around uniform for the new academic year so students arrive back at school in September looking splendid in the correct uniform.

Our uniform expectations are outlined in our [uniform policy](#) but I feel it is important to make clear the following:

- All students must wear a **Sackville School jumper** ideally identifying their community. Hoodies, zipped hoodies and non Sackville branded jumpers are not allowed to be worn around school inside or outside and are not a substitute for a coat.
- All students wearing the shirt uniform need to be wearing a **Sackville School tie**.
- **School shoes** should be **plain black**.
- Students can wear either white socks or black tights but **not both**.
- **Leggings** are not part to the school uniform and are not be worn around school.

Our new supplier, **Taylor Made Uniforms**, is a family run business based in Faygate, West Sussex and they are really looking forward to working with us. This will however mean that there will be a few small changes to how you order and collect uniform, particularly as we will no longer be able to run the uniform shop onsite.

A pop up shop will be open at Sackville School (2.30-6.00pm in the dining hall at the front of the school) on the first Thursday of every month throughout the year and every Thursday across the month of August. September they will open on Thursday 12th September.

When ordering online you will have the option to select a click and collect service; where you can collect at a pop up shop as above, or arrange delivery directly to your home (for a charge) or directly to school (free of charge).
