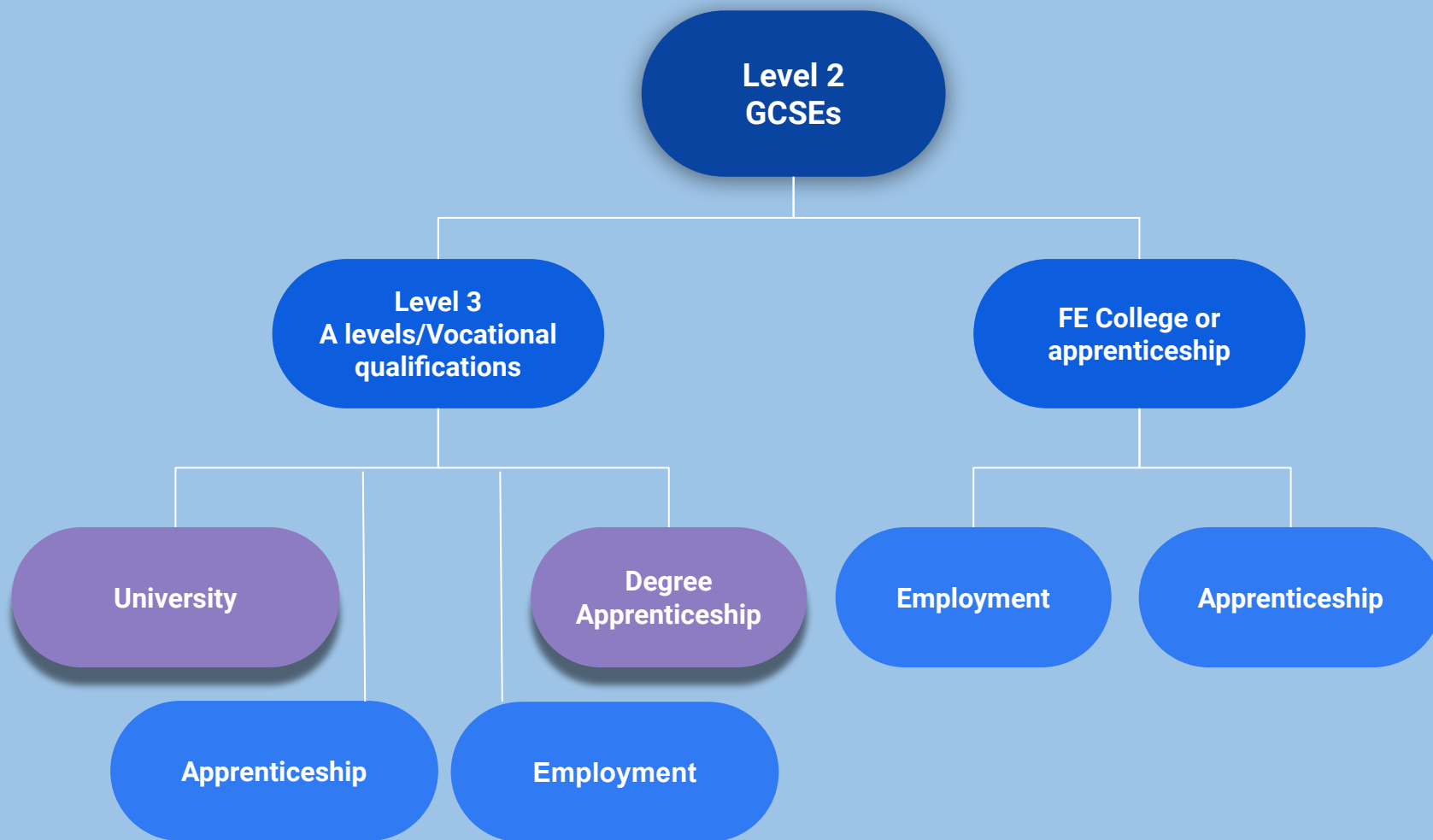

Pathways From Year 11



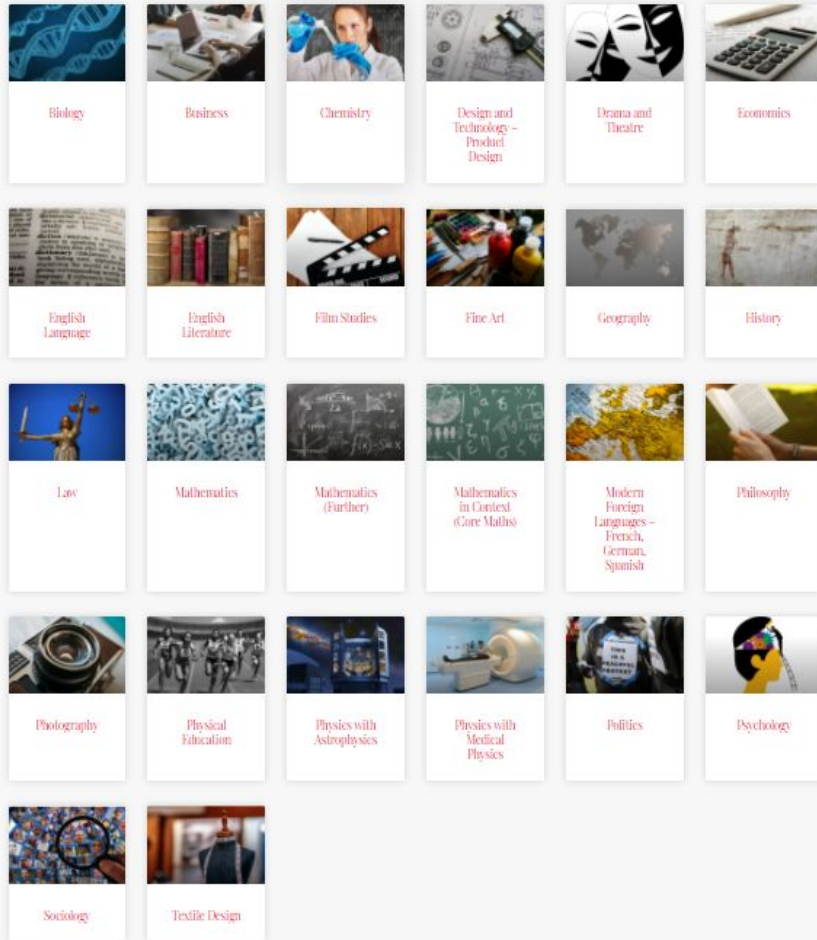
Sixth Form Achievement

- **Dedicated Oxbridge and top universities, UCAS and apprenticeship degree programmes**

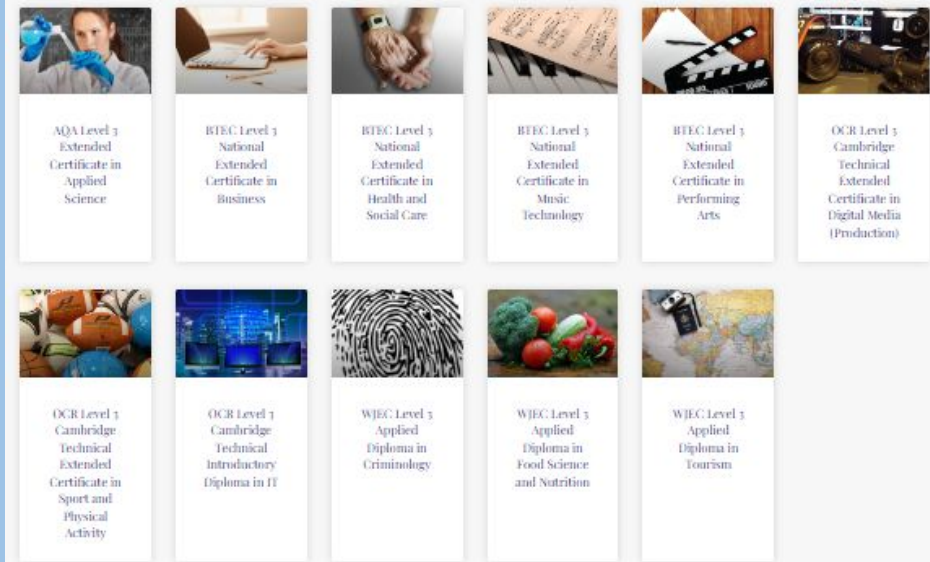



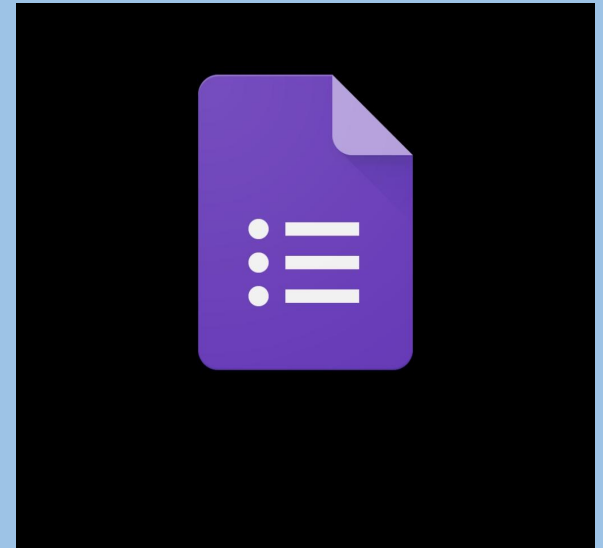
