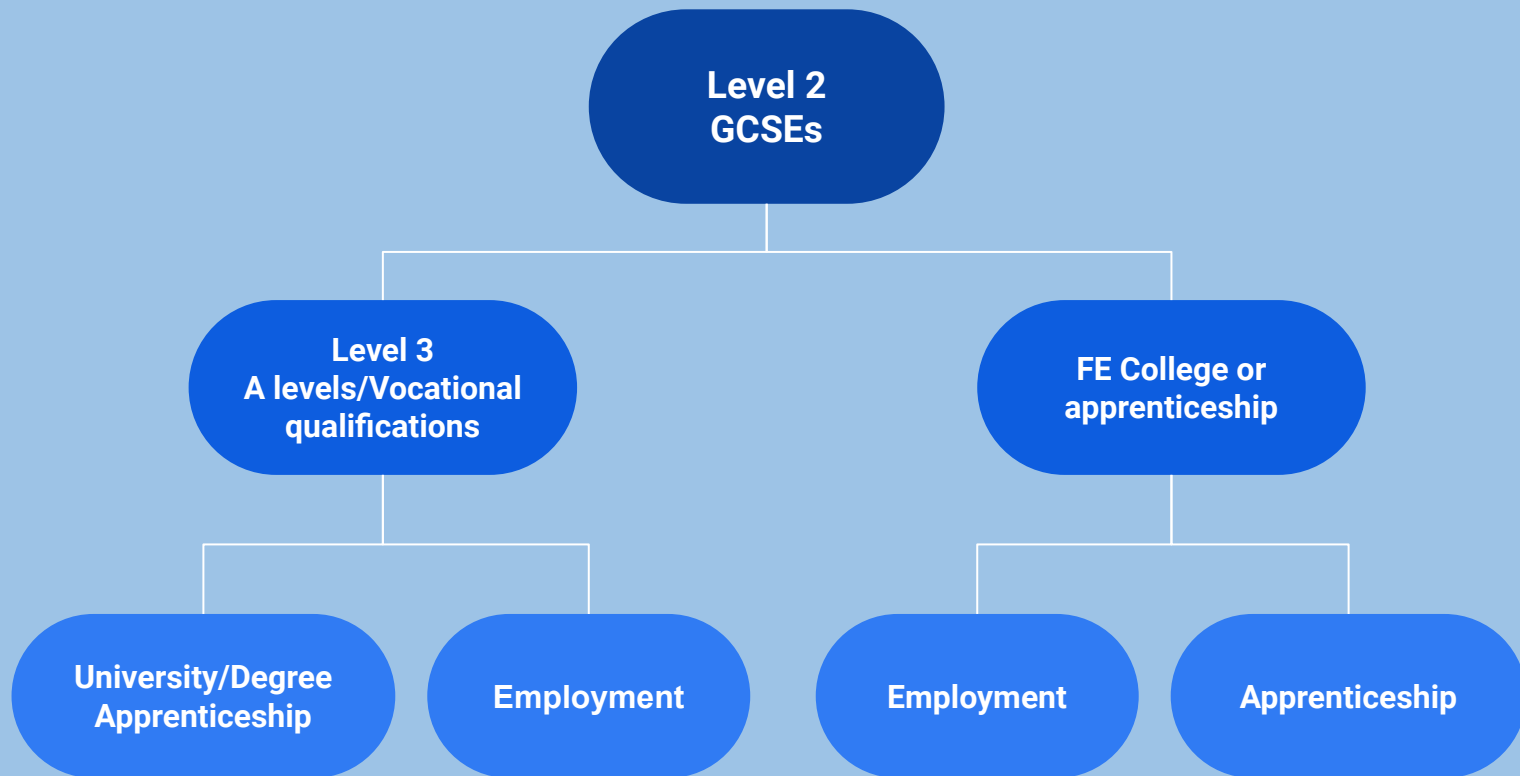
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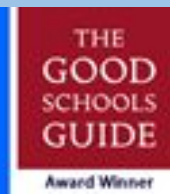



Students are encouraged to think for themselves, carry out research and prepare thoroughly for their examinations. All these skills prepare them well for higher education.

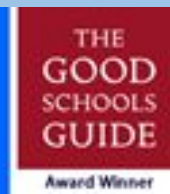

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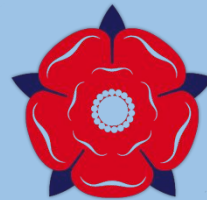
