That's why we are delivering the following **Free** Stay Safe session with the support of NSPCC and Barnardo's. Topics will include online safety, child sexual exploitation, the Prevent agenda and warning signs of radicalisation. The training is aimed at 7-12 year olds; however parents with younger and older children may also find it useful.

This session will help to build your confidence and knowledge of the online world, as well as enabling you to have conversations with your child about ways that they can protect themselves. Your child does not have to be a pupil at Sackville School for you to be able to attend.
