## **Sackville Summer School 2022 - Monday 15<sup>th</sup> August to Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> August 2022**

We have selected students both currently at Sackville and from those joining in September to come and join our Summer School 2022. The Summer School will run over three days beginning on **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> August**.

Each day will start at **9.30am** and there will be two hours of appropriate literacy, numeracy or English as an additional language (EAL) in the morning delivered by Sackville staff and sixth form assistants. Following lunch there will be a two hour activity session in the afternoon, involving sport, creative, outdoor and team building activities (some of these activities may take place offsite in the local area). Each day will finish at **2.30pm**.

This is a fantastic opportunity for students to improve their literacy and numeracy before the next academic year but at the same time develop transferable skills like leadership, teambuilding and communication alongside building relationships and self-esteem.

It is important that students come prepared for the day. Students should come dressed to do sport and other outdoor activities and depending on the weather we would advise a coat / waterproof or sun cream and a sun hat.

Though lunch will be provided each day, we would advise students to bring a water bottle and a morning snack if required.
