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THOMAS BENNETT COMMUNITY COLLEGE IS WORKING WITH CHELSEA FC FOUNDATION TO PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR STUDENTS TO DEVELOP THEIR FOOTBALLING ABILITY IN A PROFESSIONAL STYLE FOOTBALL ENVIRONMENT.

The programme aims to fulfil students' playing potential whilst meeting their educational needs by undertaking post-16 qualifications in sports, coaching and other subjects.

All academy staff are both experienced teachers and UEFA qualified coaches which enables them to deliver both the education and football elements of the course providing a consistent approach.

The programme is designed to provide students with academic qualifications in sports and coaching based on their individual needs to help create suitable exit routes and careers beyond the course for all our learners; whether it be university; a playing scholarship abroad; coaching or direct into the work place.

On the Pitch Students will be part of a full time training programme on our 4G training facility, which will cover technical, tactical and physical elements of football to an elite level, helping develop both their ability and understanding of the game.

Teams will compete in U19 National Youth Football League against other professional club programmes as well as the National and County Cup competitions to enable them to transfer their learning into real game scenarios.

UEFA' A licensed coaches will work with players in a competitive league with both development and success on the agenda.

Differing systems of play, performance analysis and individual player feedback will all create an environment designed to mature player's ability and their mental approach to the game.





NVQ Coach Education Programme

2 year Diploma equivalent to 3 full A-levels

- Completion of L3 CTEC Diploma with 6 extra units.
- Extra units added to studies to gain extended diploma during study time.
- Studying a wide range of elements of the sporting world into football context.
- Supported route into all sport science degree programmes at universities.
- Independent Study incorporated to accommodate increased workload.

Open to those with min. 6 x GCSE L5 grades including Maths & English



Level 3 CTEC Diploma in Sport Plus An Extra A-I evel

2 year study programme ending in 3 full A-levels

- 2 year Diploma equivalent to 2 full A-levels plus an extra A-Level in a supporting subject from our main 6th Form provision.
- Opportunity to specialise in a subject area of particular interest or future vocation.
- Independent Study support

Open to those with min. 6 x GCSE L5 grades including Maths & English





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Students will be given the opportunity to gain work experience placements with the Chelsea Foundation as part of their working week*.

This will give them an opportunity to work with and learn from qualified and experienced members of staff and help create a pathway to a career in the coaching industry.

Students interested in coaching will have the opportunity to apply for part-time and full time roles within Chelsea FC Foundation. Students will wear Chelsea FC training and match kit all times.

CTEC Diplomas (similar to BTEC) are designed in collaboration with experts spanning the breadth of the sector, the Cambridge Technicals in Sport and Physical Activity focuses on the skills, knowledge and understanding that today's Universities and employers demand.

These are vocational qualifications designed with the workplace in mind

whilst providing students with A-Level equivalent UCAS points to support university applications.

The course allows a wide range of assignment techniques such as coaching, presentations, videos, written assignments as well as written exams giving students a number of differing skills and experiences along the course.


