Teachers' Industrial Action Tuesday 2 May 2023

Sackville School will be closed to most children and young people on Tuesday 2 May 2023. Following a review of yesterday's industrial action and again considering our risk assessment, **Year 11, 12 and 13** have been prioritised to come into school on **Tuesday 2 May**. They should all arrive at the **normal school start time of 8.25 am** and will be able to attend their full timetable.

Other students who may be in need of additional support have also been invited in for 8.25 am. All other students should remain at home to access online learning.

Students in Years 7-10

We would like to ensure that as much learning can still take place for all students. Where possible, we will deliver live lessons via the Google Meet platform. Details of how to access this have been sent. Your child will need access to an electronic device for approximately 30 minutes each lesson.

We know this situation has been disruptive for you and your family and we apologise for any inconvenience these arrangements continue to cause. I will keep you updated as soon as we hear any more information.

Finally, please note that **all students** are expected **back in school Wednesday 3 May** at the usual time.
