



YEAR 8 HPV VACCINATION PROGRAMME - Important information for parents/guardians

Dear Families

The Immunisation Service are coming into school on **Friday 02/02/2024** to offer your child the **HPV** (Human Papillomavirus) vaccination.

You will also need the following unique School Code to complete the form: SX126089

Please complete a form to either consent or refuse to your child receiving this/these vaccination(s). The online consent form is available for completion until 11am three working days before the session date above.

If you have more than one child in the same year group, but they do not attend the same school site, you will receive a separate letter from each school site, to consent for each child, prior to their school's vaccination session. Please use the correct school code for each child.

If you have any difficulties completing the online consent form, please contact your local Immunisation Team before the cut-off date, using the telephone number provided in the attached letter, or, ask your school to notify the Immunisation Team so that we can contact you directly.

If you miss the cut off time to complete the consent form, we will not be able to vaccinate your child in school on the day of the vaccination session. The consent form will reopen one working day after the session, enabling you to submit a form for your child to be offered the vaccination, within one of our catchup clinics.

Please note that if we do not receive a consent form to consent or refuse to the vaccination(s) being offered, we will continue to contact you to complete a form to receive the vaccination(s) at a later date.
