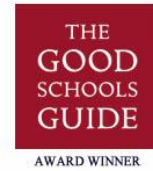

### GCSE Drama Set Text – Blood Brothers

We are writing to you concerning the GCSE drama course that your child is currently following and, in particular, about the set texts that students will be studying for the written exam.

In the exam, students will be provided with a specific extract from the play which could be any part of the play. To prepare for the exam, students will need to purchase a copy of the set text in order to make the best use of this during their lessons, independent study and revision. With their own copy, students may use highlighter pens, underline and write notes in the margin, all of which prove extremely helpful in aiding understanding and analysis.

Copies of the specified edition may be ordered through the school for £8.80. Students are beginning their study of the text this week. Although they will be able to borrow a copy in lessons, students will not be able to make notes in their text until this has been purchased and will therefore find it extremely difficult when it comes to revision.

We are also asked regularly about revision guides for this subject. Most of those available are not specific to the exam board and are therefore not particularly helpful. However, we have ordered an excellent revision guide for our set text which can be purchased through the school for £3.00, a significant discount on the RRP of £5.95.
