Year 10 and Year 11 – Blood Brothers at The Hawth, Crawley – Wednesday 19 April 2023

Students on the GCSE drama course will be studying **Blood Brothers** as a set text and we will therefore be running a trip to see a production of '**Blood Brothers**' on **Wednesday 19 April 2023** at the Hawth Theatre, Crawley. The show starts at 7.30pm and finishes at approximately 10.00pm. Students are to meet at 6.30pm outside the school's main entrance and we will be returning at approximately 10.30pm, when students can be collected from the main entrance.

Students are reminded that, although this is an enjoyable event, they are also expected to make notes on the performance and so **must** bring a **pen and paper** with them!

Students are permitted to bring money for a programme or snack; however, it is their responsibility and should be no more than £20.00.

The cost is £33.00, which will cover the ticket and coach travel. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless families, who are able to, are willing to contribute

Payment should be made via the MCAS app by Monday 27 February 2023 please.

Remember that if your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium government grant we can use that to pay for the cost of the trip.
