I am writing to you with arrangements for Curriculum Enhancement Week this July.

The week will start where students are able to select the activity they would prefer. Students can choose either to visit Sussex University, where students will have a campus tour and sample lectures etc, or to visit Plumpton College with the opportunity to look at more vocational courses and attend a workshop provided by Aim Apprenticeships, which will explore the apprenticeship route.

On Tuesday, the Futures Day is set up to give the students a great opportunity to understand the employment process and talk to employers from a variety of sectors.

This will then be followed by the year 10 sports day where students will take part in a range of sporting activities.

On Thursday, students can choose between visiting Bletchley Park, home of the code breakers, travel to London and visit the Science Museum or complete a first aid training day with St John's Ambulance. The first aid course and Bletchley Park visit are limited to 30 places each, so will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

I am very keen for every student to take part in all of the activities offered. You are invited to make a voluntary contribution which will cover the cost of the visit including transport and other incidental costs.
