Year 10 - Crime Scene to Courtroom Workshop - Wednesday 1 November 2023

I am pleased to be able to offer the year 10 sociology students the last remaining places on a one-day forensic science and courtroom workshop, which will bring to life their study of the crime and deviance topic, studied later in year 10.

Students will have the opportunity to examine a crime scene, investigate a murder based on a real case and present evidence in a mock courtroom trial. The workshop is led by a former police detective and will open the students' eyes to the wide range of future careers available in policing, forensics and the criminal justice system. It will also be excellent preparation for any students considering choosing A Level sociology or level 3 criminology in year 12.

The workshop will take place in school. Year 10 students will be off timetable on Wednesday 1 November 2023 but will start and finish school at the usual times.
