## Year 10 Curriculum Enhancement Week 2022 - Final Arrangements

As Curriculum Enhancement Week is fast approaching it is a good opportunity to give you the final details of the week.

As a reminder, the programme for year 10 in 2022 is as follows:

Uniform does not need to be worn during Curriculum Enhancement Week.

On Monday students will be taking part in a Futures Day, topics covered will include:

developing your personal 'brand'
filling in job applications and personal statements
interview skills
group problem-solving tasks

These are areas where employers regularly say young people are under-prepared and we feel this day will provide students with the experience needed when seeking employment and understanding employers' needs. In the afternoon, students will have the opportunity to speak with a range of different employers at our meet the professional's event.

On Tuesday, students will also take part in some sporting activities such as running and jumping when learning about the effects of STEM in sports. For this they can change into their PE kit, or they could come in clothes which allow them to engage in these activities without changing.

Those students traveling to Thorpe Park will need to arrive at school for 7.15am as the transport will be departing at 7.30am. We plan to return to school between 6.45pm and 7.15pm, allowing for traffic.
