Year 10 Curriculum Enhancement Week Monday 18th – Wednesday 20th July 2022

I am writing to you with arrangements for Curriculum Enhancement Week this July.

The programme for year 10 in 2022 is as follows:

Monday 18 th July	Tuesday 19 th July	Wednesday 20 th July
Futures and meet the professionals day	STEM in sport	Thorpe Park

On Monday, the futures and meet the professionals day is set up to give the students a great opportunity to understand the employment process and to be able to talk to companies from the different employment sectors.

This will then be followed by applying STEM within a sports science context on Tuesday.

Wednesday is an exciting one where students can go to Thorpe Park. The trip to Thorpe Park will be leaving at 7.00am and returning for 6.30pm, giving our students plenty of time in the park. This trip is a great way to finish off what would be their final CEW at Sackville. You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £32.50, unless your child is in possession of a valid Merlin card then the cost will be £13.50. All payments should be made via Scopay by Monday 28th March 2022.

I am very keen for every student to take part in all of the activities offered. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless parents, who are able to, are willing to contribute.

Please remember that that if your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium government grant we can use that to pay for the full cost of the trip to Thorpe Park. All you need to do is tick the consent box on Scopay. If however, you would like to make a contribution towards the trip to Thorpe Park, there is also facility to make payment.
