## Year 10 Curriculum Enhancement Week - Monday 14 July to Wednesday 16 July 2025

I am writing to you with arrangements for Curriculum Enhancement Week this July. The programme is as follows:

University or STEM visit	In school - Discovering opportunities for the future	Thorpe Park

On Monday 14 July, students will visit either Sussex University or the STEM Centre at Gatwick Airport to see the campuses and find out the opportunities available. This is an opportunity to start to plan their future pathways and investigate the different pathways available to them. Students will find out their destination this week.

- Arrive at school 8.25am sharp
- Lunch Students will need a packed lunch. Nut related products are not allowed to be taken on any school visit.

On Tuesday 15 July, each student will participate in a mock interview. Prior to this, they will have written their CV's and covering letters in workshops held in tutor times for a job they have chosen. Each student will then have a pre-interview workshop followed by a mock interview with an external person and then a debrief session with their tutors. This is designed to give students practice of the application and interview process. There will also be a range of other activities throughout this day.

- Arrive at school 8.25am sharp
- Lunch Canteen and dining hall will be open as normal
- Dismissal 2.55pm at normal time

Wednesday is where students will go to Thorpe Park. There will be a curriculum provision in school for students not attending Thorpe Park consisting of core subjects.

- Arrive at school 7.45am
- Lunch Will need a packed lunch and/or spending money for inside the park. Nut related products are not allowed to be taken on any school visit.
