## Year 10 Residential Field Trip to South Wales - Thursday 11 July to Saturday 13 July 2024

We are planning a field trip to South Wales from Thursday 11 July to Saturday 13 July 2024 in order to enrich the curriculum and for the students to participate in fieldwork which is an important part of their GCSE course. South Wales provides an excellent case study for many elements of the course and provides a more stimulating environment for fieldwork than the local area. It is hoped that all year 10 geographers will take up this opportunity. However, any students not attending this trip will receive the required support from their class teacher, enabling them to successfully complete the fieldwork based examination questions, which they will be required to answer in their final geography GCSE examination.

We will be staying in student accommodation at the University of Swansea which is located close to the beach where we hope to spend time in the evening (weather permitting). Accommodation is full board and students will receive hot meals in the mornings and evenings, and a packed lunch on the Friday.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £250.00 which will cover the cost of the field trip, which includes accommodation, full board and transport. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the trip, the trip will not take place unless parents, who are able to, are willing to contribute.

Please remember that if your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium government grant we can use that to pay for some of the cost of the trip.
