Year 10 Residential Trip to Disneyland Paris - Sunday 18 January to Wednesday 21 January 2026

We are planning a residential trip to Disneyland Paris for January 2026. This is to enrich the curriculum offer in Business Studies and Enterprise and will help bring some elements of the course to life. The students will complete work on the trip about Business at Disneyland as well as attend a talk from Disney staff. This is not a compulsory part of the course and students who do not go on the trip will not be disadvantaged.

We will be staying at the Hotel Cheyenne (subject to availability) on the Disneyland Paris site, which is a short walk to the park. Accommodation is on a bed and breakfast basis and therefore students will need to buy their own lunch and evening meals. For planning purposes, allow £30 per day for additional food. This can be done cheaper and there is a McDonald's in the resort and students can bring snacks and provisions with them (and into the parks).

The itinerary of the trip is as follows:

- Sunday 18 January 2026:
 - o Leave Sackville School by coach (early morning)
 - o Ferry crossing
 - o Arrive at Disneyland about 4.00pm
 - o Settle into accommodation
- Monday 19 January 2026:
 - o Breakfast
 - o Business talk
 - o Day in the theme park
- Tuesday 20 January 2026:
 - o Breakfast
 - o Day in the theme park
 - o Student assignment
- Wednesday 21 January 2026:
 - o Breakfast
 - o Sightseeing coach tour of Paris
 - o Return home via Ferry

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £609.00 which will cover the cost of the trip, which includes bed and breakfast as well as transport. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the trip, the trip will not take place unless parents, who are able to, are willing to contribute.

The trip can be paid in instalments as outlined below:

To secure your place on the business trip to Disneyland Paris, please make a payment of £50.00 via the MCAS App by Friday 13 June 2025. There is currently a limit of 40 students for this trip. If we receive more demand, we will operate a waiting list.

Please remember that if your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium government grant we may be able to provide a small contribution to the cost. Please contact me if this is the case. You will need to make the initial deposit of £50.00 in order to secure your place.

Insurance for all school trips is arranged through West Sussex County Council. Full details of the policy can be found on our [website](#). **Peanuts or peanut related products are not allowed to be taken on any school visit.** As always, this trip will require all students to be well behaved and trusted and we reserve the right to refuse students from attending this trip based on behaviour.

Further details of the trip, including a more detailed itinerary and kit list, will be sent out closer to the time of the trip.
