## GCSE English Literature and GCSE English Language March Mock Revision Sessions

We are going to be providing a series of revision sessions over the coming weeks to help students prepare for their March mocks in English.

The revision sessions will be open to all students from year 11 and will run on Tuesdays and Wednesdays across three weeks leading up to the half-term break. All topics covered in the sessions directly relate to these exams. Students will not need to sign up for these sessions and are free to attend any session they feel will benefit them.

These sessions will operate on a 'first come, first served' basis, so we advise students to arrive promptly for their sessions to secure their place.

All sessions (apart from those on *Lord of the Flies* **D06**) will take place in **D05** and will **run between 2.45pm and 3.30pm**.

Monday 7 <sup>th</sup> March	English Literature: Either 'An Inspector Calls' or
