Year 12 - A Level Art Equipment

A Level art students are expected to document their progress over the course through A3 sketchbooks. Students are welcome to purchase these from outside of school, but we can also provide these through the school for a discounted cost. Students will usually use two sketchbooks over the year and payment for these can be made on the MCAS app for £20.00. (This also includes two plastic folders, one A2 for school and one A3 for transporting their book home).

The cost of art materials is ever increasing and students studying art A Level will use a large breadth of them over the course. These include the use of cartridge paper, acrylics, inks, spray paint, clay and much more. We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £20.00 towards the costs of these materials which can also be paid on the MCAS app.

Art students also have the opportunity to purchase an art pack to use at home for their independent learning if they wish.

The art pack for home includes the following materials and costs a total of £40.00:

- KOH-I-NOOR graphite crayon
- Rubber
- Palette knife painting tool
- Glue stick

Any materials bought from us will be distributed to students in class once payments have been made online.
