Year 12 Biology Trip to Wakehurst Place - Wednesday 02 July 2025

The biology department at Sackville School are organising a trip for year 12 students to Wakehurst Place on Wednesday 02 July 2025.

The visit is intended to enhance and support the biology A-level curriculum by putting into practice various genetic concepts that they will be learning in year 13. Moreover, students will have a chance to gain vital fieldwork experience by collecting and analysing DNA. This is a core component of the practical side of the course which students will need to be able to demonstrate in order to pass (PAG 6: DNA electrophoresis).

Students will be travelling in the school minibus, leaving Sackville at 9.30am and will return to school by 3.30pm, subject to traffic conditions. **Nut related products are not allowed to be taken on any school visit**.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £32, which will cover the cost of fuel and the tutors guiding students on the day. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of this trip, it will not take place unless parents, who are able to, are willing to contribute.
