Year 12 Chemistry Trip to London on Monday 14 November 2022

On Monday 14 November we are planning a trip to London to enrich the curriculum by giving students the opportunity to watch some chemistry lectures on some of the most up to date and interesting research.

The lectures will take place at the Emanuel Centre in London from 10.45am to 3.45pm.

It is hoped that all our year 12 chemists will take up this opportunity, however, any students not attending this trip will be provided with either the opportunity to watch the lectures online or some work to practice relevant skills. Any work set will be found on the Google Classroom.

As all of the students are over 16 years old, we think it is a good opportunity for them to get practiced at travelling independently. There is a map with instructions attached to this letter.

By train, it costs approximately £20.00 (ticket prices are subject to change, so this is just an estimate) for one adult ticket during off-peak times. It might be cheaper for them to go as a group and get a group train ticket.

Students should bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink as there will be limited opportunity to buy refreshments while we are in London. Students should wear comfortable shoes for walking around the city and do not need to wear school uniform. Please ensure students have a waterproof jacket to cover all eventualities with the weather!

Lecture tickets cost £27.00 and payment **(if not made already)** needs to be made via [Scopay](#) by **Monday 17 October**, as I need to confirm the final number attending on this date. There are 25 tickets available, therefore, should the trip become oversubscribed we will complete a ballot to allocate places in a fair manner. We have tried to keep the cost of this trip as low as possible.

Please remember that if your child is eligible for the 16-19 bursary we can use that to pay for the full cost. Please contact the sixth form for more details.

Insurance for all school trips is arranged through West Sussex County Council. Full details of the policy can be found on our website [here](#). **Peanuts or peanut related products are not allowed to be taken on any school visit.**
