'Crime scene to court room' workshop – Wednesday 12 October 2022

I have arranged a one-day forensic science and courtroom workshop to bring to life the year 12 criminology students' studies. This will be particularly relevant to their study of unit 3 next year. Students will have the opportunity to examine a crime scene, investigate a murder based on a real case and present evidence in a mock courtroom trial. The workshop is led by trainers with experience of working in the criminal justice system and will open the students' eyes to the wide range of future careers that exist in this sector. It will also be excellent preparation for any students considering applying to study sociology, psychology, law or criminology at University.

The workshop will take place in school. The students will be off timetable for the whole day and will start and finish school at the usual times.
