## Year 12 Economics - Visit to the Bank of England Museum – Friday 30 June 2023

We are offering all year 12 Economics students the opportunity to attend a visit to the City of London on **Friday 30 June 2023**. Mr de Souza, Mr Dupoy and I believe this will be an extremely valuable day for the students. We will be visiting the Bank of England Museum and will also hear from City employees about their jobs. This will support the students' A level Economics studies, and also allow them to learn more about potential degree courses, apprenticeships and careers in Finance.

We request that students dress according to the sixth form dress code and wear comfortable shoes, as there will be plenty of walking and the weather is likely to be warm. They should bring a refillable water bottle and snacks for the journey, and either a packed lunch, or money to buy lunch. Please ensure we are advised of any medication your student requires and that they also bring this with them on the day e.g. asthma pumps.

We will meet at East Grinstead train station at 8.45am, returning around 4.20pm. You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £12.85, which will be no more than the price of a GroupSave return train ticket to London. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of this event, it will not take place unless parents, who are able to, are willing to contribute. You will be able to make payment via the MCAS app, once we have finalised the ticketing arrangements.

Please remember that if your child is eligible for the 16-19 bursary we can use that to pay for the full cost. Please contact the sixth form office for more details.
