Work Experience - Chailey Heritage: Monday 15th - Friday 19th June 2015

We are delighted to inform you your daughter has expressed an interest in completing a one week work experience placement at Chailey Heritage as part of her Btec Health and Social Care course. The placements are now confirmed.

Placement information

Chailey Heritage is a day and residential school for the severely mentally and physically disabled; it is a leading institution in its field and judged by Ofsted as Outstanding. We have forged strong links with the school in the past few years and last year gave a substantial donation to the school from our charity fundraising, as a result of the health and social care visits to the school.

The week of work experience will be invaluable 'hands on' experience and will complement the academic studies of the girls. Students will be assisting in classes. This could be cooking, DIY, gardening, painting, pottery, handicrafts or music. Students will have to keep a log book – this log book is structured and will be of direct assistance to the coursework we will be completing on our course in September 2015.

The work experience will not only have benefits for coursework, it will also have wider benefits. Students will receive a certificate of attendance at the end of the week. Those hoping to follow a health or social care career or a career in education will find this a useful enhancement to future applications.

Dates and times

We are mindful of the pressure of work on the girls, so we have chosen a week shortly after the year 12 exams. This is a time when students have the opportunity for some extension work and wider experiences. Students will be expected to attend as follows:

Dates: Monday 15th - Friday 19th June 2015

Times: 9.30am - 3.30pm

Transport

We are pleased to inform you we can provide transport to Chailey Heritage every morning via school minibus. However, due to our teaching commitments, we are unable to provide transport home at the end of the day. We wonder if it may be possible for parents/carers to club together and work out a rota for transport home for the five days.
