The performance is produced by the physical theatre company 'Frantic Assembly', a practitioner studied during the BTEC course.

Please could students meet at 11.50am in P block, ready to leave school at approximately 12.00pm. We will be traveling by coach. The performance will begin at 2.30pm and will be returning to school at approximately 7.00pm where students can be collected from the main entrance.
