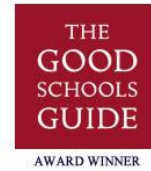

Dear Parent/Carer

Year 13 CTECH Sports Assessment - Rock climbing – Wednesday 4th March 2020

As part of the CTECH sport course students are required to complete a practical unit. This unit requires students to get evidence of 1 individual sport, 1 team sport and 1 outdoor and adventurous activity (OAA). In order to complete the OAA section of this unit we will be taking the students rock climbing.

We have an opportunity on Wednesday 4th March to take your child off-site for the day in order for him/her to be assessed in rock climbing at Blacklands Farm. This course is run by experienced and qualified instructors who have a high rate of success in gaining excellent scores when teaching the skills of rock climbing. We are giving your child the chance to take part in this activity in order to improve their overall practical grade.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £40 which will cover the cost of the visit including transport and other incidental costs. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute. Insurance for all school trips is arranged through West Sussex County Council. If current circumstances make it difficult to meet the contribution, please do not hesitate to contact me in confidence to discuss whether it is possible to reach some mutual arrangement.

Students will need to wear their PE top with tracksuit bottoms and a sweatshirt or hoodie. In case of poor weather they will also need to bring a waterproof coat and extra layers. They will need sturdy trainers and a packed lunch. The school will provide transport to Blacklands Farm in the morning and will return the students to school for 3.00pm.
