Year 13 Health and Social Care visit to Chailey Heritage - Monday 20 October 2025

I would like to inform you of a mandatory visit to Chailey Heritage Foundation (https://www.chf.org.uk/), for our Year 13 Health and Social Care students. This visit forms the basis for their Unit 12 coursework, the notes taken and the write up of our visit is put forward as part of the assessed coursework. It is therefore not an optional visit.

Chailey Heritage is a school for children and young adults with complex and severe physical and mental disabilities.

The focus of the visit will be looking at educational care plans and adaptations made for physically and mentally impaired children and young adults. Students will gather information and apply it to their case studies for their written coursework.

This visit will have no charge and takes place on Monday 20 October 2025, departing school at 11.00am and returning by lunchtime at 1.25pm. It takes place during Health and Social Care lesson time, so no lessons will be missed.

The arrangements are as follows:

- Students will meet Mrs Sands at the exit of the Sackville Centre, end of lesson two. Here they will be registered.
- Students will leave for Chailey Heritage, complete their case study fact finding visit and then return to school by the latest of 1.25pm, so they will get their full lunchtime.

Transport is by school minibus, which Mrs Sands will be driving. Insurance for all school trips is arranged through West Sussex County Council. Full details of the policy can be found on our <u>website</u>. Please can I ask you to sign the <u>Google Form</u> by Thursday 16 October 2025.

Mrs Sands is looking forward to taking your child to Chailey Heritage.
