## Year 7 Curriculum Enhancement Week from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July – Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022

You may be aware that each year at the end of the summer term Sackville suspends the normal timetable for three days for an ‘activities week’ that we call Curriculum Enhancement Week.

On the Monday and Tuesday, activities will be run in bands depending upon which tutor group your child is part of. Wednesday will be our year 7 annual sports day.

Following on from Mr Johnson’s letter, students will be visiting Seaford as part of the geography curriculum, this will be a great opportunity to support their learning.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £10.00, which will cover the cost of the visit including transport and other incidental costs. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless parents, who are able to, are willing to contribute. Payment of the £10.00 should be made via Scopay by Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

Please remember that if your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium government grant we will use that to pay for the full cost of the trip to Seaford. All you need to do is tick the consent box on Scopay.
