## Year 7 Trip to the Sussex Coast on Monday 18th and Tuesday 19th July 2022

As part of year 7 Curriculum Enhancement Week, we are planning on taking year 7 students to the Sussex coast.

We will travel by coach to Seaford, on the East Sussex coast, to investigate physical and human geography processes and landscapes. The purpose of the trip is to enrich the curriculum being taught in the classroom and to develop data collection and field work skills in a real world setting.

The trip will run within normal school hours so no alternative travel arrangements will need to be made.

Forms groups 7AMS, 7DPT, 7JBK, 7JBV and 7MLE (K-band) will go on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July and students in 7ACE, 7JMR, 7KOR, 7MTY and 7VSR (J-band) will go on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £10.00, which will cover the cost of the visit including transport and other incidental costs. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit and therefore the visit will not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute. Payment should be made via Scopay, no later than Friday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2022.

Please remember that if your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium government grant we will use that to pay for the full cost of the trip to Seaford. All you need to do is tick the consent box on Scopay.

Insurance for all school trips is arranged through West Sussex County Council. Full details of the policy can be found on our website at <u>https://sackville.w-sussex.sch.uk/parents/school-trip-insurance/</u>. **Peanuts or peanut related products are not allowed to be taken on any school.** 

It will not be necessary to wear school uniform on the trip but it is essential that all students wear weather appropriate clothing and suitable footwear and that they bring a waterproof jacket and a packed lunch. There will be nowhere for students to buy food during the day.
