Year 8 Science Trip to Faraday Challenge at Warden Park School Thursday 13th January 2022

On 13th January the science department at Sackville school will be entering a team of year 8 science students into a science challenge day at Warden Park School. As one of the very top performers in the year group, your child has been selected to represent the school and take part in this exciting competition.

The competition involves a mystery science task which will be a hands-on problem solving and critical thinking activity and a competition against students from other schools in West Sussex. The challenge day is organised by the Institution of Technology and Engineering together with Warden Park School. I will send an email link to you with further information about this challenge day.

We will travel to and return from the venue via school minibus. Students will be required to meet in the reception area in school at 8.25am before departing to Warden Park School. The prize giving ceremony at Warden Park ends at 3.00pm. Therefore, we anticipate arriving back at Sackville at approximately 3.30pm.

There is no charge for this event but the students will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks. **Peanuts or peanut related products are not allowed to be taken on any school visit**. Students will also of course need to wear full school uniform so that we can properly represent the school.
