Foodbank is a charity that receives donations from various sources, including schools and then creates food parcels for local people who, for whatever reason, are struggling to provide their family with food. East Grinstead has a Foodbank branch and it is this branch I wish to generate donations from the school community and then deliver with the help of some year 9 students.

Donations are to be brought into school on the week beginning 13^{th} October and taken to the Conference room, located next to the staff room.

Foodbank has specific goods that they have asked for at this time, they are the following:
